RENEWAL PROCESS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What documents do I need for the license renewal?

- 1. Current and active DBPR Transient Public Lodging Establishment License
- 2. Current and active Certificate of Registration with Florida Department of Revenue
- 3. Current and active Liability Insurance
- 4. Advertisements of the vacation rental property must display the City of Sunny Isles Beach approved vacation rental license number

Any changes to responsible party or the property owner will require a new license. Incomplete applications will be denied. Owners or responsible parties will receive an email of missing documentation.

What are the fees for the Short-Term Vacation Rental License renewal?

Fees are paid by credit card online:

- Local Business Tax Receipt: \$100
- Short-Term Vacation Rental License \$300

Renewal fees are paid after the application is reviewed and approved.

*The fees charged by the Planning and Zoning Department for Short-Term Vacation Rental Licenses, pursuant to Resolution 2019-2957, are non-refundable.

When can I submit a Short-Term Vacation Rental renewal application?

Online renewal applications will be accepted starting August 31, 2020. All applications must be submitted by September 30, 2020.

Where can I submit a Short-Term Vacation Rental renewal application?

Applications can be submitted online through your portal account.

Are there any late fees in the renewal process?

Yes, a late fee of \$50 will be added to all applications submitted on or after October 1.
