The primary election is on August 20, and the general election will be on November 5. Voters will not only decide who will be our next president, but also cast their votes for federal representatives, state representatives, special state legislation, state Supreme Court, ballot measures, county mayor, and municipal government officials. It seems like a lot and one may even wonder what impact our vote has in guiding the direction of this country at a federal, state, and local level. According to Statista, voter turnout in this country for the past three general elections ranged between 56% and 61%, which is similar to voter turnout in Sunny Isles Beach. One must note that voting matters because it puts pressure on candidates and

## Adhering to the New July 1, 2024 Laws: Condo Transparency and Administration

Over the past 2 I/2 years, I have heard from and assisted many condo owners throughout Sunny Isles Beach with questions regarding condo records requests, board meeting schedules, insurance, certifications, and assessments. Due to severe assessments in some condos, many elderly residents have sadly become financially stressed and could benefit from simple legal advice.

Many recent contacts with residents have referred to a lack of condo board adherence to certain by-law sections relating to elections, quarterly meetings, and notices thereof. As of July I, condo managers will need to be more transparent regarding the production of condo documents, meeting notices, adherence to by-laws, and elections. The problem

arises when assessments hit without adequate documentation regarding contracts associated with those assessments, the

bidding process, and the qualifications of the contractor doing the work.

I am available to assist any condo manager with pool or spa issues, elevator problems, permit hangups, and other issues involving the City, County, or State.

## **GETTING READY FOR THE**

## NEW SCHOOL YEAR



As the new school year approaches, it's important to plan ahead to ensure a smooth transition. Here are some key tips to help you get started on the right foot.

#### **SAFETY**

Ensuring a safe and successful school year for you and your family starts at home. Before the first day of school, parents and guardians should talk with their children about a safety plan.

**Emergency Plans:** Teach your children what to do in case they get lost. Establish a meet-up spot in case of emergencies and make sure they memorize their parent or guardian's full name and phone number. Additionally, parents should educate their children on how to avoid tricks from strangers.

## **TRAFFIC & SCHOOL ZONES**

Sunny Isles Beach is home to Norman S. Edelcup/Sunny Isles Beach K-8 School, located at 201 182 Drive. The community around the school should anticipate different traffic patterns in this area. Please allow extra time to get around the school during arrival and departure times. Remember to always follow the designated 15 mph speed limit in school zones.





## **DROP-OFF & PICK-UP**

**Driving:** If driving your child to school, obey school zone speed limits and follow the school's drop off and pick-up procedure. The designated drop-off and pick-up point is on the east side of the school on Atlantic Blvd. Make sure your child exits or enters from the passenger side of the vehicle in a timely manner to keep the line moving efficiently.

**Parking:** Do not park or drop off your child in the school's parking garage or the the RK shopping plaza. Your car could be subject to towing by the private property owner.

**Walking:** If walking your child to school, please use pedestrian crosswalks and obey crossing guards.

**Bicycles and Scooters:** If your child bikes or rides a scooter to school, make sure they always wear a properly fitted helmet.

A short-term rental is any condominium unit rented to guests for a stay of 6 months or less.

Renew by **September 30** each year to avoid a \$50 late fee.

## New Parking Rates For Non-Residents: Residents Can Register For Discount Program

Beginning August 1, parking fees at municipal lots around Sunny Isles Beach will increase by \$2 per hour. Beach parking lots at Ellen Wynne and Pier Park will go from \$3 to \$5 per hour. Other municipal lots, including Gateway Park garage and Heritage Park garage, will increase from \$2 to \$4 per hour.
